



## WAX REPORT - Rangely Loppet 50km Freestyle, Saturday, March 2nd

Date: February 27, 2024

Location: Rangely, ME

Snow & Weather Conditions
<b>Wednesday</b> Showers. High near 49. South wind around 10 mph, with gusts as high as 20 mph. Chance of precipitation is 80%. New precipitation amounts between a tenth and quarter of an inch possible.
<b>Wednesday Night</b> Rain and snow showers, becoming all snow after 1am. Low around 10. Breezy, with a south wind 10 to 15 mph becoming west 20 to 25 mph after midnight. Winds could gust as high as 45 mph. Chance of precipitation is 90%. New snow accumulation of less than a half inch possible.
<b>Thursday</b> Partly sunny, with a high near 15. Wind chill values as low as -10. Breezy, with a west wind 20 to 25 mph, with gusts as high as 45 mph.
<b>Thursday Night</b> Partly cloudy, with a low around 4. Breezy, with a west wind around 20 mph, with gusts as high as 35 mph.
<b>Friday</b> Mostly sunny, with a high near 33. Breezy.
<b>Friday Night</b> Mostly clear, with a low around 25.
<b>Saturday</b> Partly sunny, with a high near 49.
<b>Saturday Night</b> Partly cloudy, with a low around 32.
<b>Sunday</b> Mostly sunny, with a high near 51

Tier 1 - Recommendations	Tier 2 - Recommendations
Glide Wax: HS10, ironed in at 150C. Scrape and brush.  Top Coat: TST10 Block. Apply with Roto Wool T18W. Brush with T0190B or T01900 Fine Red Nylon Brush.  Structure: T0410-100V..	Glide Wax: Marathon Black Powder as base ironed in at 155C, Scrape and brush. Then TS10 Black (165C). Scrape and brush  Top Coat: TS10 Liquid. Apply with felt cork Roto Fleece. Brush out with T01900 Fine Red Nylon Brush.  Structure: T0410-100V.



**NOTES:** Rain mid week with no significant accumulation of new snow. Manage skis for debris on course and old snow. High of 49F and sunny. Structure will be important as temps rise rapidly.
